Can you help us?

We are looking for a **Volunteer Finance Assistant** to support our organisation as we move from a small volunteer-led charity to a sustainable community business. If you are a **resourceful person with an eye for detail, self-motivated and have excellent organisational and IT skills**, then this role offers you excellent development and growth opportunities. This would be an excellent position for someone who has recently retired from a role in finance and is looking for an opportunity to get involved in their local community, or someone looking for experience of working in the charities sector and applying their financial skills and knowledge to support a small charity.

What do we need you for?

You would work with our Trustees and core staff team and will be responsible for **general finance operations including data entry, suppliers' liaison and general administration tasks such as filing and archiving**.

It would also be a perfect role for someone who has recently retired and is looking for an opportunity to contribute to their community through volunteering to support a local charity.
